Key Accountabilities & Duties	
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Diagnosis, assessment and treatment	Demonstrates knowledge of physical therapy modalities.
	Perform treatment techniques to improve patient mobility, including breathing and relaxation techniques, therapeutic exercise, manual therapy and soft tissue techniques, electrotherapy modalities. Gait training , pain management, cold/heat therapy .
	Ability to perform appropriate assessment on all patients related to the therapy requested and provided and reassessments. This includes adolescent, geriatric patients and the general patient population.
	Assess, evaluate, diagnose and plan an individualized exercise program as well as provide education to enable the patient to self-manage their condition. These include breathing and cough techniques to manage COPD and falls prevention programs for patients at high risk.
	Provide treatments for conditions such as Musculoskeletal conditions, geriatric conditions, women’s health issues, chronic conditions and facial palsy.
	Provide assessment, education as well as self-management programs to support patients with obesity, diabetes, arthritis and other chronic diseases.
	Treats patients and their families with respect and dignity. Identifies and addresses psychosocial, cultural, ethnic and religious/spiritual needs of patients and family.
	Provide patients with treatments including, manual therapy, therapeutic physical exercises and the application of electro-physical modalities.
	Develop treatment plans according to patient’s individual needs, history profile, and symptoms.
	Provide consultation sessions on physical health improvement, in accordance with regulatory requirements, and credentialing requirements.
Follow-up on patient’s progress and response to exercise programs, to identify needed program change.	
Team work and Process Improvement	Coordinates delegates and supervises responsibilities assigned to supportive staff and participate in operational aspects of the department, maintains performance improvement activities within the department and participates in Quality assurance activities.
	Ensures that patient changes are accurate and entered on a timely basis. Participates in all infection control, departmental equipment training, organizational safety and fire safety programs.
