GENDER DISTRIBUTION BY AGE GROUPS

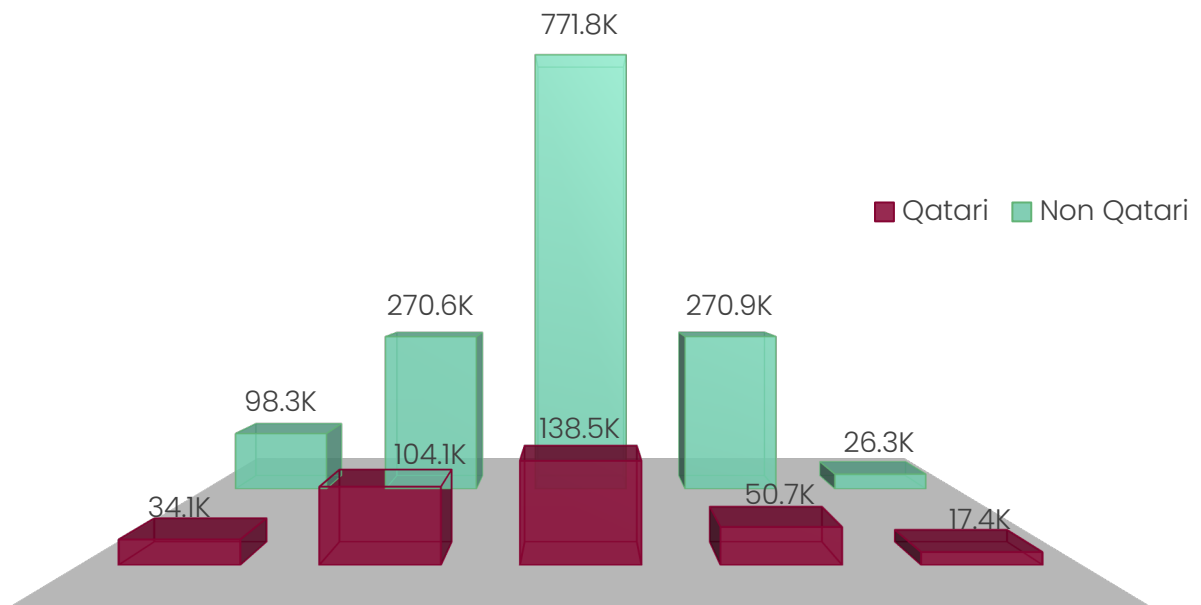

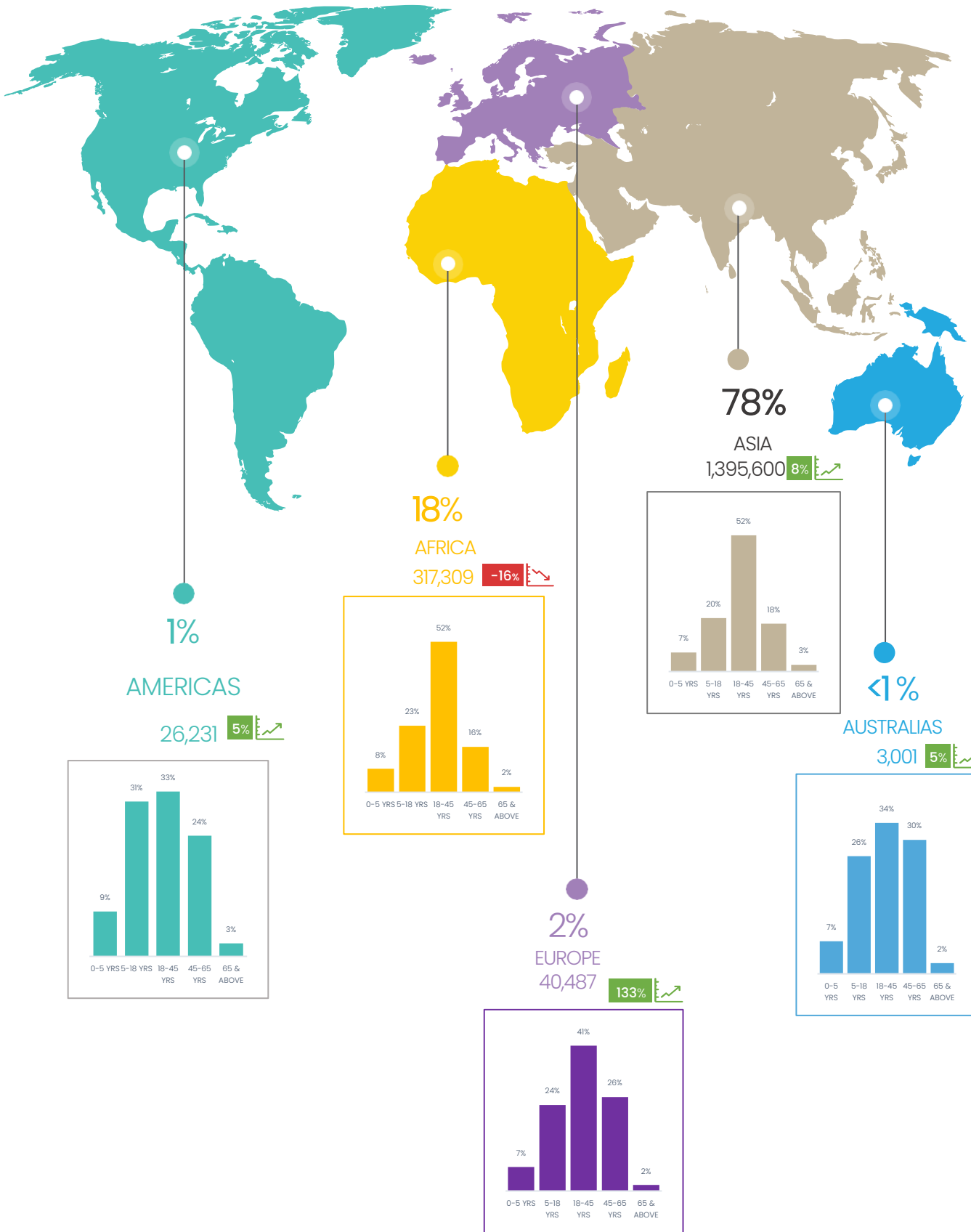


AGE GROUPS BY NATIONALITY

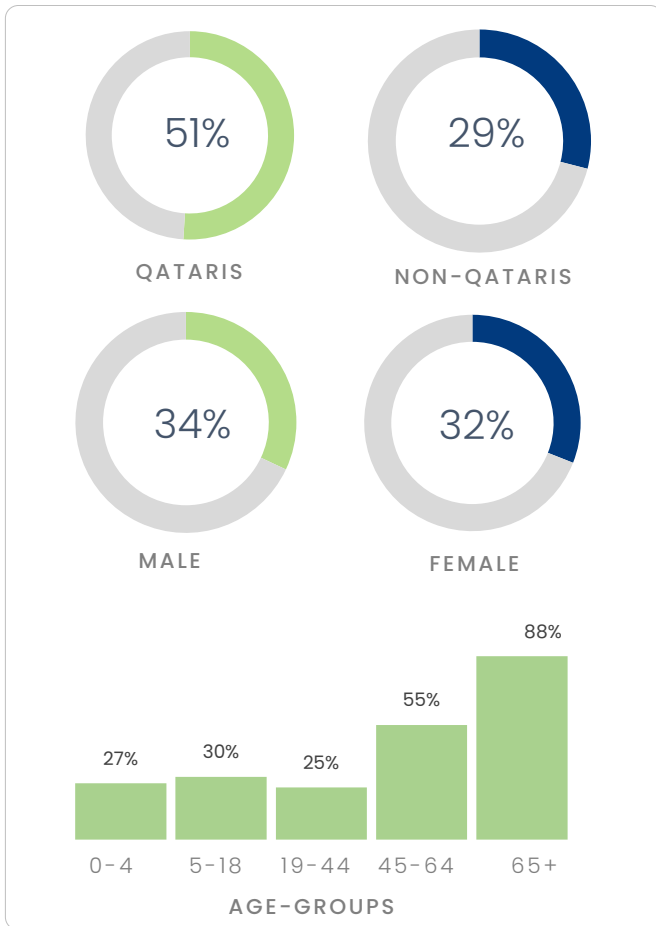

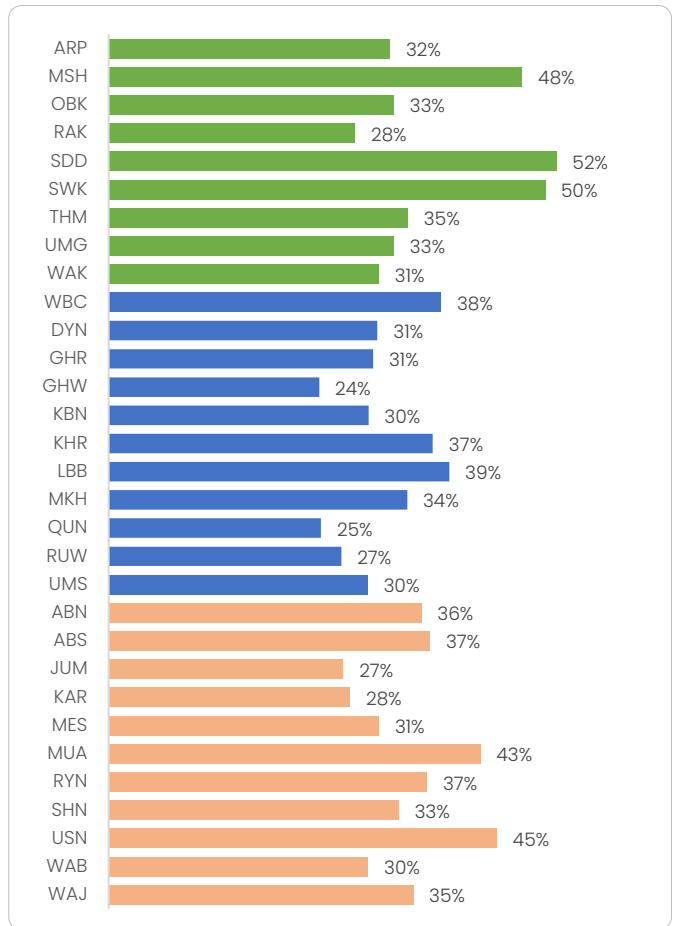

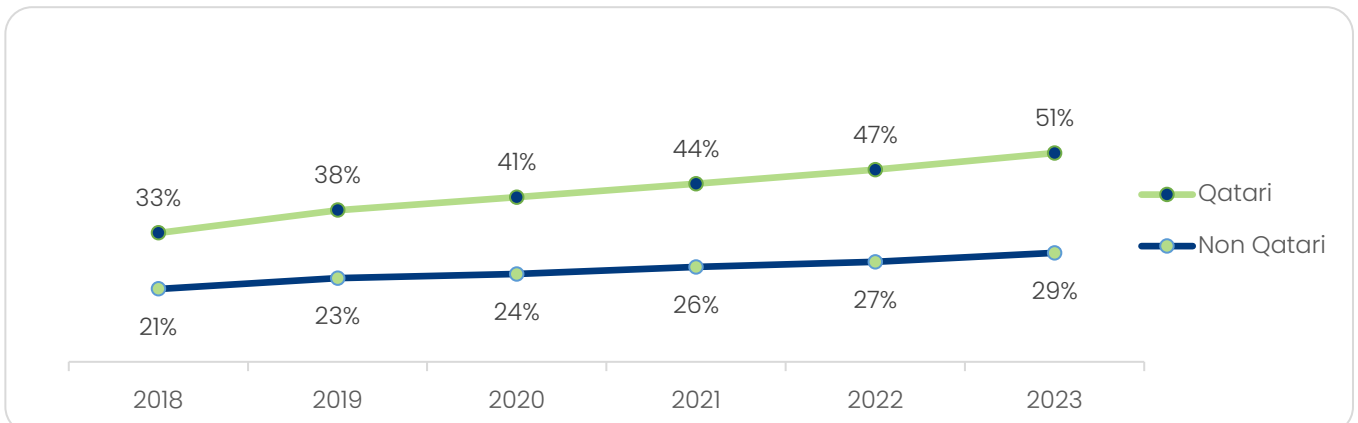


% OF PATIENTS WITH CHRONIC CONDITION BY HC

PATIENTS DIAGNOSED WITH A CHRONIC DISEASE, 2018-2023

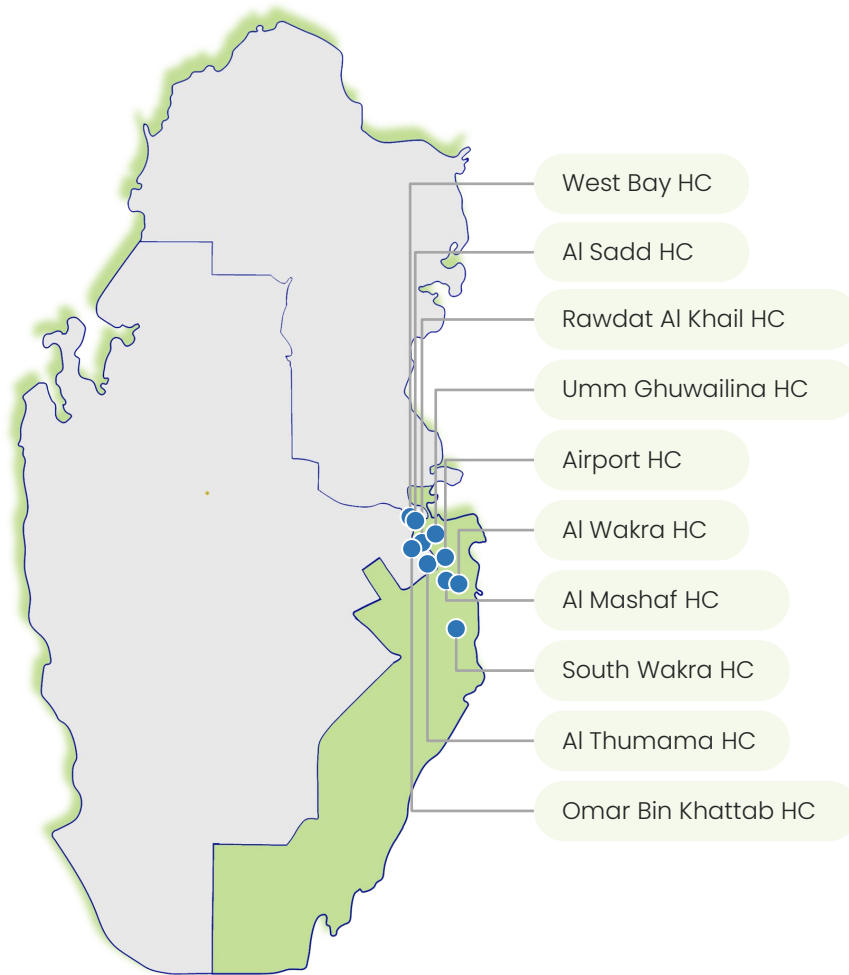

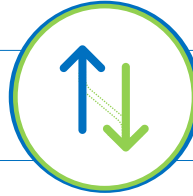

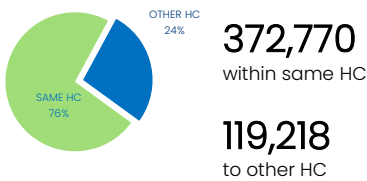

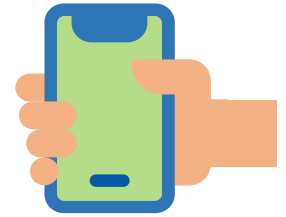

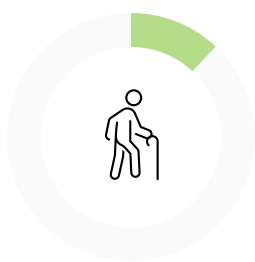

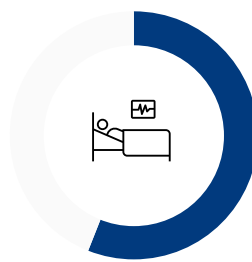

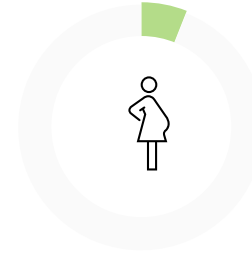
RATE OF TELE-CONSULTATIONS OVER TOTAL VISITS - BY PRIORITY PATIENT GROUPS



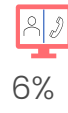

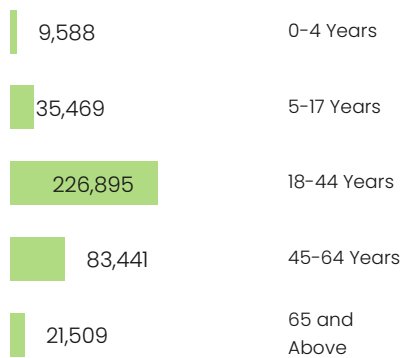

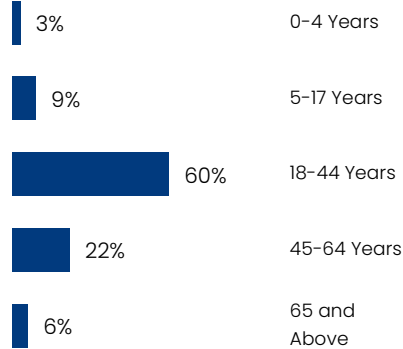

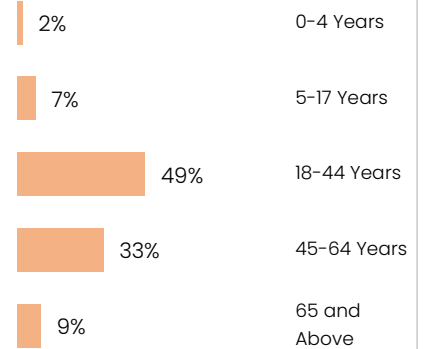

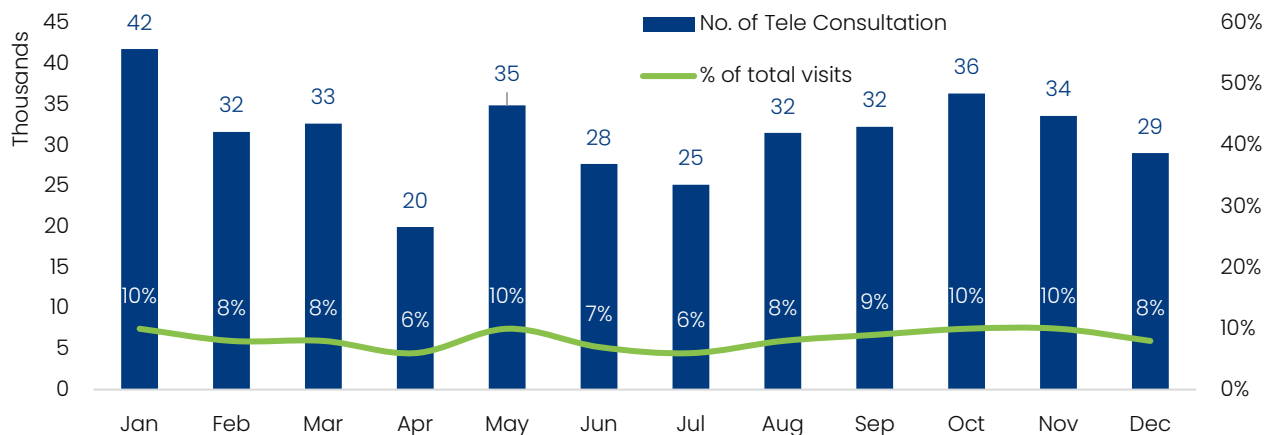
% OF TELE CONSULTS OUT OF TOTAL VISITS

RADIOLOGY VISIT VOLUMES BY HEALTH CENTERS

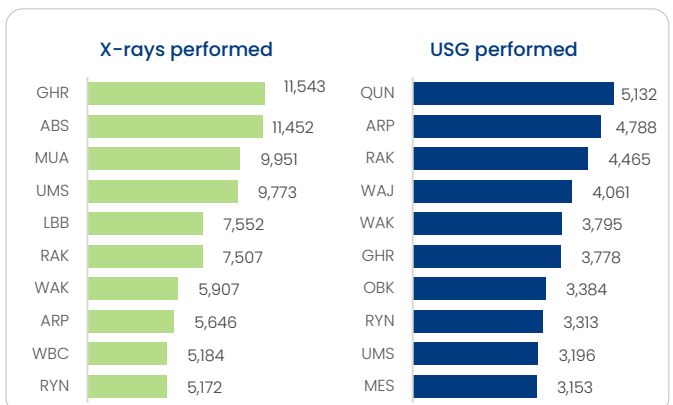

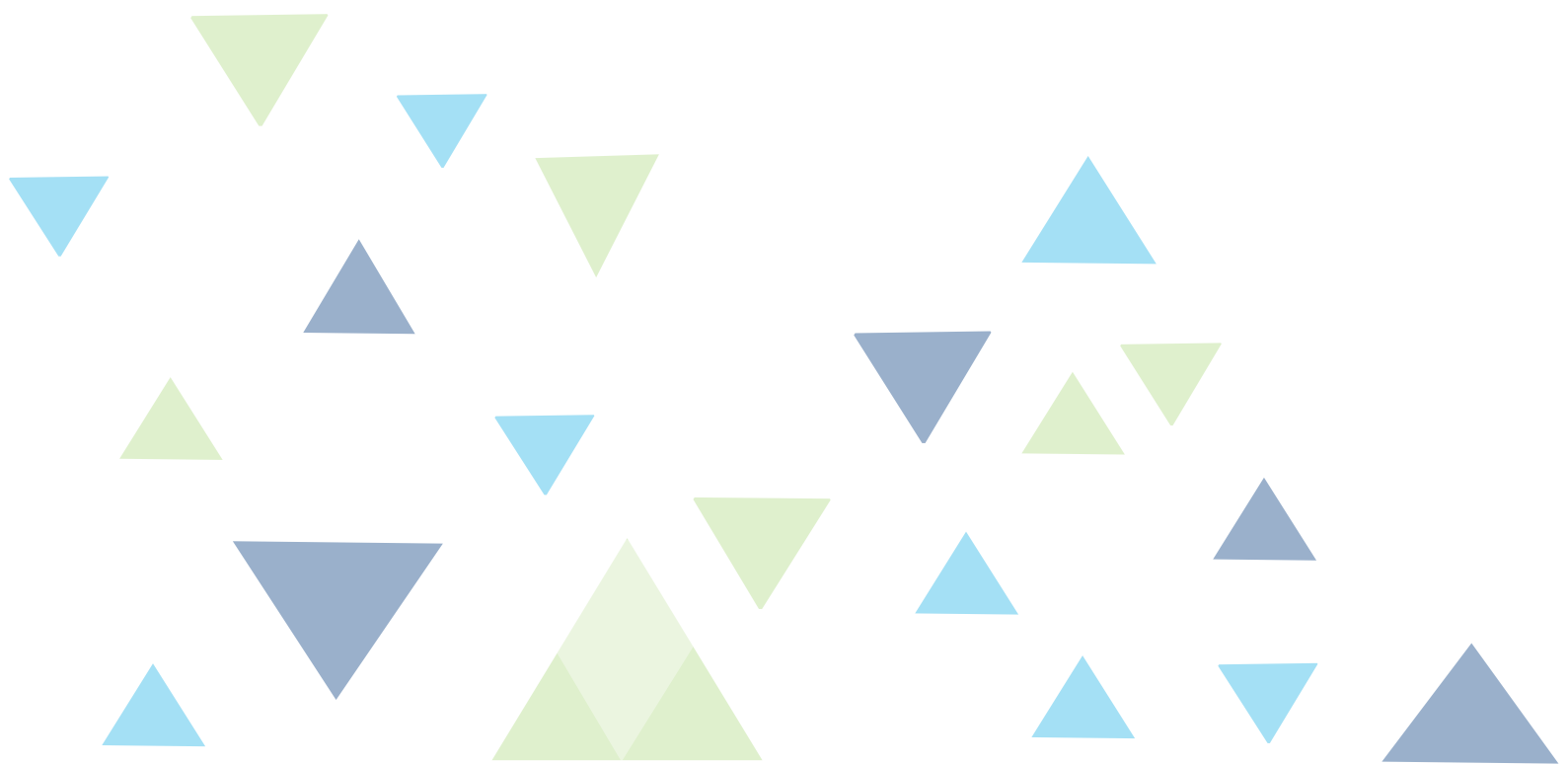
